

Important Points on R15 Regulation:

The candidate shall pursue a course of study not less than 4 academic years and not more than eight academic years. After eight academic years of course of study, the candidate is permitted to write the examinations for two more years. The candidate shall register for 226 (224+2 credits for Gender Sensitization) and secure 218 (216+2) credits and all practical subjects, Industry oriented mini project, Comprehensive Viva-Voce, Seminar and Project work are compulsory subjects. The student can avail exemption of two subjects upto 8 credits, that is, one open elective and one elective subject OR two elective subjects.

Academic Requirements : A student is eligible to write the University examinations only if he/she acquires a minimum of 75% of attendance in aggregate of all the subjects. Condonation of shortage of attendance in aggregate up to 10% (65% and above and below 75%) in each semester or first year may be granted by the College Academic Committee Shortage of Attendance below 65% in aggregate shall not be condoned. If any candidate fulfills the attendance requirement in the present semester or first year, he/she shall not be eligible for readmission into the same class.

Minimum Academic Requirements : A student is deemed to have satisfied the minimum academic requirements if he/she has earned the credits allotted to each theory/practical design/drawing subject/project and secures not less than 35% of marks in the end semester exam, and minimum 40% of marks in the sum total of the mid-term and end semester exams.

Minimum Academic Requirements for the Promotion in Next Year:

1. A Student is eligible to write the University Examination Only he secures 75% Attendance during the Semester.

2. Condonation of Shortage of Attendance is Upto 10%. So the Students Securing not less than 65% can be granted to write the Examinations, but not less than that.

3. The Students will be promoted to next year, if he/she has secured not less than 35% marks in the Externals Examinations and not less than 40% marks collectively in Internals and End Term Examinations.

4. To be promoted from I Year to II Year, every Student must Secure 28 Credits Out of 56 Credits in First Year. So A Student will not be promoted from I Year to II Year if he fails to Secure 28 Credits along with the prescribed attendance.

5. A Student will not be promoted from II Year to III Year if he fails to Secure 50 Credits Out of 84 Credits in II-I or 68 Credits upto II-II out of 112 Credits. It doesn't matter whether he has missed any examination. Also A Student must fulfil the Attendance requirements along with these.

6. To be promoted from III Year to IV Year, every students must Secure not less than 84 Credits from the total Credits of 140 upto III-I Semester or a total of 100 Credits out of 168 up to III Year II Semester.

7. Students who fail to earn 216 Credits Out of 224 Credits within 10 Years from the Year of their admission shall forfeit their seat in B.Tech and their admission will automatically be cancelled.
